The origin of ICAZ can be traced back to the International Symposium on “Domestikationsforschung und Geschichte der Haustiere” which was held in 1971 in Budapest, Hungary. This meeting is considered to be the “First” ICAZ International Conference. The second International Conference was held in 1974 in Groningen, The Netherlands, where participants began to draft the first set of ICAZ Statutes. To date, ICAZ has sponsored eight International Conferences.
